PRE BALLETT- Pink tights and leotard.

BALLET I/III- Pink tights, light blue leotard and pink ballet slippers

BALLET IV/V-Girls-Pink tights, navy blue leotard and pink ballet slippers

Boys-White close fitted T-shirt, black footed tights and black ballet slippers

BALLET VI-Girls-Pink tights, Black leotard and pink ballet slippers.

Boys-White fitted T-shirt, black footed tights and black ballet slippers

Please come to the theater with light make-up, Hair should be put in a tight, high bun on the back of the head. Please use a hair net and gel. Remember no jewelry and no nail polish. Instruction for Hair and Make up at chamberdancesf.org.

We are trying to encourage the dancers to remember to take good care of their costumes so there will be a \$5.00 fee if their costumes are not hung properly after each performance. Please, encourage them to do so.

Any dancers that would like to go into the theater to watch the second half of the performance are welcome to join the audience but they will have to change into their street clothes.

Much time and energy goes into the production of these performances and it is a very important part of the "total dance experience" for our young dancers. It is their reward and time of recognition for the time and the effort that they have spent in the classroom during the year.
